Visitor Fact Sheet

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN VISITING

Updated January 16th, 2021

We strongly recommended informing the floor nurse manager prior to coming in for your visit. We have a screener scheduled at the front door M-F 9am -7pm and 9am -5pm on weekends. Visits are permitted outside of this schedule and any time of a residents choosing.

- 1) All visitors must arrive at the main entrance of the facility and must present with a verified negative COVID test result within the last 24 hours.**
- 2) All visitors must arrive at facility with mask covering nose and mouth. Visitors will be provided a medical grade mask and it must remain in place when you are around any residents.**
- 3) The safest practice is for residents and visitors to wear face coverings or masks and physically distance, particularly if either of them is an increased risk for severe disease or are unvaccinated.**
- 4) All visitors will have to check in at the (registry area) for temperature check, completion of COVID screening tool, prior to visitation. It is recommended you arrive five minutes prior to scheduled visit for this to be completed.**
- 5) All visitors will be asked to wash hands with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer prior to leaving the check in area.**
- 6) All visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by someone over 18.**
- 7) Visits will be held in a designated area. Visitors must go directly to the designated area to limit movement throughout the facility. Whenever possible, visits will be held in designated outside areas. Substitutions may be made in inclement weather, and at facility discretion.**
- 8) All common visitation areas will be completely sanitized between family visits.**
- 9) If your loved one is quarantining (up to 14 days from admission) then visitation is permitted in their room.**
- 10) Any violation of the listed guidelines will cause us to restrict your visitation at FLCL.**
