Safari on Apple computer

- 1. Open Safari.
- 2. Click the bolded word **Safari** in the upper left corner of the page, shown circled below.



3. On the menu that appears, select **Preferences**.

4. On the *Preferences* menu that appears, click the **Privacy** icon. In the *Privacy* options, make sure the **Cookies and website data** section is set to **Always allow**.

Safari on iPhone/iPad

- 1. Open the **Settings** app on your iPhone/iPad.
- 2. In Settings, scroll down until you find **Safari**, and tap it.
- 3. In the Safari settings, scroll down to the **Privacy & Security** section and tap **Block Cookies**.
- 4. In the list of options that appear, tap **Always Allow**.
- 5. Close the **Settings** app.

You will have to close Safari on your iPhone/iPad and re-open it in order for this change to take effect.
